MGS League Fee*	\$105.00
Refundable Concession Stand Fee**	\$20.00
Skills Clinic (optional)	\$15.00

For multiple players:

2nd sister add \$55 League Fee, No Concession Fee.
3rd sister add \$20 League Fee, No Concession Fee.

* A late fee of \$20 will be assessed for each player registered after January 31, 2010.

** Parents will be requested to sign up to work the concession stand by the team manager before start of the season.

Non-residents a \$15 surcharge, even if they attend a Munster school.

Registration is open to anyone, regardless of residence, at least 5.5 years old OR up to the age of 17 as of January 1, 2010.



AGE/GRADE RULE: Girls can choose to register to play in a specific division based on her age OR the grade she will enter in the Fall of 2010. See the registration form for specifics. New participants must bring a birth certificate copy or a current report card as verification of the player's age or grade respectively.

UNIFORMS: Each girl will be sized for a uniform shirt and black shorts at registration. Jr. Miss and older players wearing black shorts must provide a sliding pad. Sliding pads, sliding shorts and other MGS Spiritwear items will be available for purchase at Registration.

FIELD MAINTENANCE: Each family is asked to work a pre-season two hour shift to help prepare the fields for safe playing.



MGS YOUTH UMPIRE PROGRAM: The MGS Youth Umpire Program is looking for young people interested in becoming umpires for MGS. The program is open to girls and boys age 14 and up, and is designed to teach responsibility and to provide quality umpires. Preference will be given to Munster residents. Umpires must attend a two day umpire clinic. Attendance at an annual rules clinic is also required. Participants pay for training and uniform, some of which is reimbursed by MGS after umpiring five games.
